A	Enter medium walk-continue on center line to C.	Straightness on center line.	10
C	Turn right.	Balance of turn.	10
B	Circle right 10 meters.	Steadiness of walk. Roundness of circle.	10
B-F-A-K	Medium walk.	Steadiness of walk.	10
K-X-M	Free walk.	Quality of walk with relaxation. Straightness of diagonal line.	10x2
M	Medium walk	Smoothness of transition.	10
E	Circle left 10 meters.	Steadiness of walk. Roundness of circle.	10
E-A	Medium walk.	Steadiness of walk.	10
A	Down center line.	Accuracy and smoothness of turn.	10
X	Halt, salute.	Straightness on center line. Smoothness of transition. Immobility of halt.	10

Leave the arena in free walk on long rein. Exit at A.

RIDER'S INDEPENDENCE FROM HANDLER (Rider being able to perform the test with minimal assistance from handler)	10	2
SUBMISSION (attention and confidence, harmony, lightness and ease of movements, acceptance of the bit)	10	2
RIDER'S EQUITATION (position and seat, correctness and effect of the aids)	10	2

Additional Lead Line Safety Rules

1. Lead line riders must have their feet in stirrups.
2. The lead must be either attached to the cavesson or a halter placed over the bridle. Leads may not be attached directly to the bit.
