Six ribbons in all divisions.

All dogs must be on leash.

Directions:

From Lexington & further North:

I 81 South to I 64 West. Take first exit off I 64, Exit 55 to Lexington. Go left on Rt. 11 South. Proceed thru 3 traffic lights. On bridge that crosses over the Maury river the road forks. Stay in middle lane, to Rt. 11 bypass. At next light continue straight onto Rt. 251 (Link Road). Proceed 4+ miles. Cross over Buffalo Creek, immediately turn Left on Cedar Hill Church Rd (Rt. 675). Proceed 1.2 miles, at "T" turn right onto Zollmans Mill Road..

Welcome! Follow signs to parking area.

From Natural Bridge & South of Lexington:

I 81 North to exit 180. At top of exit ramp turn left onto Rt. 11 North. Proceed on Rt. 11 approximately 6.5 miles to first stop light. At light turn left on 251 (Link Rd.). Proceed 4+ miles. Cross over Buffalo creek immediately turn Left on Cedar Hill Church Rd (Rt. 675). Proceed 1.2 miles, at "T" turn Right on Zollmans Mill Rd.
