## CLASS DESCRIPTION:

**Assessments: Friday** (space is limited...preference will be given to clinic participants). Assessments are done 3 to a class, take approx 1½ hours.

**Level 1: Sat & Sun from 9a to 1p.** This is class is for those beginning your journey in Parelli. It is the first step to developing a relationship with your horse based on respect and partnership. The whole aim of Level 1 is to overcome "Opposition Reflex" and to teach you the rudiments of the language called "horse". This class does not have a pre-requisite. Equip needed- rope halter, 12' lead line, carrot stick w/savvy string, saddle & pad.

**Level 2: Sat & Sun from 2p to 6p.** In Level 1 you made changes in the way you think, learning to consider your horse's point of view and to understand the predator-prey relationship challenges. Now in Level 2 you learn how to develop that relationship into a mutually rewarding experience -- through communication, confidence, timing and fluidity. Ground skills and riding skills covered. This class is appropriate for those that can pass the Level 1 assessment. Each Level 2 class is unique and a variety of Level 2 tasks will be covered so even if you have taken a Level 2 class before, you can be sure that you will learn new skills each time you take the class. Equip needed- rope halter, 12' lead line, 22' line (optional), carrot stick w/savvy string, hackamore or bridle, saddle & pad.

### **Lessons: Monday**

Private, Semi Private, Group lessons available to clinic participants and Mid/Adv Level 2 students only, on a limited basis. Prices vary

**IMPORTANT INFO:** Please mark or label your equipment so you'll know which one is yours. A limited amount of PNH equipment will be available for purchase the day of the clinic, please contact coordinator for special orders. We recommend that you order equipment or home study programs prior to the class. You can order through Kelly's website at [www.kellysigler.com](http://www.kellysigler.com) ...click "shop". If you are pregnant and wish to participate, please contact clinic coordinator before registering for any classes. If Kelly deems a horse to be unsafe to be in a class, she reserves the right to ask the student to no longer participate with that horse. If you have any questions about this, please contact the clinic coordinator.

**HEALTH CERTIFICATE AND COGGINS:** A current negative coggins is required for all horses. State of VA requires Health Certificates for horses entering from out of state.

**STABLING:** Limited stabling (stall or paddock) is available to those that need it. Cost is \$25 per night for stall or paddock. 1 bag of shavings is included, additional shavings can be purchased for \$6 bag. **You will need to bring your own hay & feed. Feed buckets are available in stall. Need to bring water bucket for stall or paddock and feed pans for paddock.** You will be responsible for cleaning your own stall and mucking out at the end of the clinic.

**HOURS:** Check in one hour before class starts. **Please have rider fees and paperwork in by or before May 9 (for spring clinic) or September 30 (for fall clinic) so check in will run smoothly.** The morning clinic is from 9 am to 1pm the afternoon clinic is from 2 pm to 6 pm. There will be short breaks in the morning and afternoon. Riders are welcome to audit the other clinic free of charge.

**COST:** To participate with your horse in either of the 2 day clinics the fee is **\$285 plus a \$50 facility fee.** Contact **Clinic Coordinator** listed above to register. You will receive the Rider Registration and Liability Waiver forms by e-mail or snail mail or fax. Please complete and mail or fax these forms with your check for **\$285** (made out to **Kelly Sigler**) to **Lydia Moyer 664 Somerset Dr. Lawrenceville, GA 30045. Fax # 866-604-2451** You may pay with a credit card through PayPal (small fee added) by visiting Kelly's website [www.kellysigler.com](http://www.kellysigler.com) and clicking on the rider fee next to the class you plan to take. Your rider position is confirmed after receipt of payment. Participants are allowed to bring one auditor free. Please list his/her name on your registration form. **The stabling fee and facility fee will need to be paid when you arrive at the clinic at the check in table.**

**AUDITORS:** To audit a clinic means to have a position in the audience...like auditing a college class. Kelly

welcomes class related questions from auditors during class and will be happy to answer other questions during breaks. You will want to bring a comfortable chair and sunscreen as the arena is not covered. The fee is \$25 for 1 day \$50 for 2 days (to audit both classes). Savvy Club Members, bring your card and receive \$5 off the audit fee per day. Children under the age of 12 accompanying a paying adult are admitted free. Signing up in advance is not required.

**FOOD:** There are restaurants within 6 miles of the facility. If you are unable to leave for lunch, someone will be available to make a lunch run. A breakfast snack, coffee & water will be provided at no charge.

**FACILITY:** The arena is not covered.

**STALLIONS AND DOGS:** Stallions are not permitted. Dogs are permitted on leash only.

**CANCELLATIONS:** Please give us 30 days notice in order to fill your rider position.

**OTHER:** It is suggested that you bring sunscreen as the facility is not covered. There are cows/calves next door that the horses may be able to see. There are loose working farm dogs on the property.

**From Lexington & further North:**

I-81 South to I-64 West. Take 1st exit off I-64, Exit 55 to Lexington. Go left on Rt. 11 South. Proceed thru 3 traffic lights. Cross bridge over Maury River, road forks so stay to left onto Rt.11 Bypass. At next light continue straight onto Rt. 251 (Link Rd). Proceed ~ 5 miles. Cross bridge over Buffalo Creek & turn left on Cedar Hill Church Rd (Rt 675). Go 1 mile. At "T" (no stop sign) turn right onto Zollmans Mill Road. Go 1/10th mile, road ends at Broadview Ranch. **From Natural Bridge & South of Lexington:**

I-81 North to Rt. 11 North/Natural Bridge Exit 180. At top of exit ramp turn left onto Rt. 11 North. Travel ~ 7 miles and turn left at the Rt. 11 bypass/Rt 251 intersection (traffic light). Proceed ~ 5 miles. Cross bridge over Buffalo Creek & turn left on Cedar Hill Church Rd (Rt 675). Go 1 mile. At "T" (no stop sign) turn right onto Zollmans Mill Road. Go 1/10th mile road ends at Broadview Ranch. Follow signs for parking. [Click for printer friendly directions.](#)

**From East of Lexington:**

I-64 West Take Exit 55 to Lexington then follow "From Lexington" directions

**Or**  
From Buena Vista, VA take Rt. 60 West. As you enter Lexington, go through first stop light, get in the left lane and turn left onto the Rt. 11 By-pass just before the second stop light. Go approximately 1 mile to the stoplight - go straight through. You will now be on Rt.251. Proceed ~5 miles. Cross bridge over Buffalo Creek & turn left onto Cedar Hill Church Rd (Rt. 675). Go 1 mile. At "T" (no stop sign) turn right onto Zollmans Mill Road. Go 1/10th mile road ends at Broadview Ranch. Follow signs for parking.

**From West of Lexington:**

I-64 east Take Exit 55 to Lexington, then follow "From Lexington" directions.
